- A reading committee will evaluate abstracts and will accept the maximum number of eight.
- Speakers will receive an honorary Certificate of Participation

- The papers to be published must not be longer than 15 pages.
- The paper must apply to the fundamental research, writing and publication standards.
- The deadline for paper submissions is: 15/02/2015.
- The finished papers that will be sent for evaluation and publication must be in **Word** format.
