What is Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II?

Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II is a scholarship scheme for exchange and cooperation between Europe and North Africa. It is an Erasmus Mundus Action 2 project which organizes and manages scholarships financed by the European Commission for members of Al Idrisi II partner and associate universities and nationals from Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia and the European Union. Selected grantees may follow a credit transfer, short stay or full degree programme at one of the partner universities.

What are the aims of Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II?

- ★ To allow undergraduate and master students, doctoral candidates, post-doctoral fellows, experienced researchers as well as academic and administrative staff to gain valuable experience, knowledge and contacts abroad.
- ★ To provide improved education and training opportunities for vulnerable groups and socio-economically disadvantaged students, and promote equal access to higher education for students from least developed regions.
- ▼ To exchange knowledge, know-how and experience between Europe and North Africa reinforcing the teaching and research capacities of the partner universities.
- **★** To set up International Cooperation Cells in research, teaching and administration.
- **★** To promote common areas of higher education.

How does the scholarship scheme for the 2nd call for applications work?

for nationals from EU countries

If you are enrolled or registered at a European partner university you can apply for:

- **★** Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)
- **★** Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate, experienced researchers, academic and administrative staff)

If you are enrolled or registered at a European university not included in the Al Idrisi II partnership you can apply for:

★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate, experienced researchers, academic and administrative staff)

for nationals from Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia

If you are enrolled at a partner university in Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco or Tunisia you can apply for:

- **★** Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)
- ★ Short stay programmes (doctorate, post-doctorate, experienced researchers, academic and administrative staff)

If you are enrolled or registered at a higher education institution in Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco or Tunisia not included in the Al Idrisi II partnership you can apply for:

* Short stay programmes (doctorate, post-doctorate, experienced researchers, academic and administrative staff)

If you can prove that you are in a particularly vulnerable situation you can apply for:

★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)

What are International Cooperation Cells?

International Cooperation Cells (ICCs) are small projects that were proposed with the help of Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi grantees. They are a structured way to promote and consolidate cooperation channels among partner and associate universities on both sides of the Mediterranean. ICCs tackle specific topics in research, teaching, training or administration. The list of selected ICCs is published on the Al Idrisi website. Applicants who will work for ICCs and have their explicit support will have strong preference for 6 months doctorate, 6 months post-doctoral and/or 1 month staff grants.

How to apply?

If you want to apply for an Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II scholarship, you must fill in the online application available on the Al Idrisi website:

What does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship covers a monthly allowance, tuition fees, health, travel and accident insurance and expenses for one economy class round trip.

Master	Not avalaible for the 2 nd call	1,000 €
Doctorate	6 months	1,500 €
Post-doctorate, experienced researchers	6 months	1,800 €
Staff	1 month	2,500 €

All partner universities offer a wide range of disciplines. As Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II focuses strongly on regional needs, the following specific thematic areas will be given priority in the selection process:

- **★** Soil and Water Sciences

- **★** Sustainable Development
- **★ Communication and Information Sciences**

Administrative staff mobility is also considered a priority by the Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II partnership.

Applications that are explicitely sopported by one of the selected International Cooperation Cells will also be strongly favoured.
